Dear Parents, Guardians and Students,

The Board of Directors, the management of the school and all of the staff wish to convey our sincere congratulations to the Class of 2025 on another superb set of Leaving Certificate results.

The Class of 2025 exceeded all expectations through their resilience and hard work, and we are extremely proud of their achievements.

The teaching staff deserve enormous credit for their dedication to their students with nine years in a row of an academic average of over 480 points, highlighting the consistence of educational excellence throughout both our Senior and Junior School.

The 2025 class average CAO Points is a superb **483 points** per student.

In 2025,

- 8.7% attained in excess of 600 points**
- 26% attained in excess of 550 points**
- 42.4% attained in excess of 500 points**
- 72% attained over 450 points**
- 81.5% attained over 400 points**
- 92% attained over 350 points**
- 96% attained over 300 points**

8 students attained in excess of 600 points, including 1 student attaining 9 H1 grades.

47% of honours grades were attained at H1 and H2 level

87% of honours grades were attained at H1, H2, H3 and H4 level
