


# Introduction

# **Engagement in School Life**

- Attending Parent-Teacher Meetings and Parent Information Evenings is essential for effective communication and collaboration between home and school.
- Supporting key school events such as Sports and Prize Day, St. Gerard's Day Mass, Carol Service and School Musical and Drama productions fosters a sense of belonging.
- We encourage and welcome your attendance at school-organised and Parents' Association talks and presentations on topical issues relevant to your child.
- We invite you to get involved by encouraging and supporting our students in extracurricular activities and sports, contributing to fundraising campaigns and initiatives, joining in School celebrations, or sharing your expertise on special projects. Your participation enriches our School community and helps our children thrive!

# **Ensuring a Safe and Positive School Environment**

- To ensure the safety of our students, we ask parents to remain vigilant and ensure adequate supervision of young children at all times.

# **Supporting Positive Communication**

At St. Gerard's School, we aim to engage in **collaborative**, **supportive** and **constructive** communication between all members of our School community.

We are committed to working together to find positive solutions to issues that may arise. Should you have an important or complex concern, we encourage you to reach out to the class teacher, Head of Year, Deputy Principal or Principal to arrange a meeting. Should further support be needed, our School's *Complaints Procedure* is available as a next step or as an alternative approach.

To facilitate **positive communication and collaboration** between School and home we ask that parents/guardians observe the following guidelines:

#### Communication

- All members of our School community should maintain the highest standards of conduct when interacting with students, members of staff, Sports Coaches and other parents/guardians.
- Everyone must ensure that the language used in conversations that take place on the school grounds or at any School-related events is **respectful and appropriate**.
- All members of the School community should be mindful of not labelling incidents inappropriately or prematurely.

#### **Email**

- Respect, courtesy and consideration must be shown in written communications with all members of the School community.
- Parents/guardians should be aware that while staff will respond as promptly as possible, communications received outside working hours may be addressed during school hours.

# Social Media/ WhatsApp Groups

- We ask that parents/guardians seek relevant information from official School channels. Class/Year-Group WhatsApp groups are not an official means of communication by or for the School.
- Comments about any member of our St Gerard's School community or about any School policy, or photos, screen-grabs or live-streaming of school events/activities must not be shared on any social media platform.

- Completing Student Information Forms and Medical Forms promptly assists the School in remaining informed and up-to-date.
- It is important to follow School guidelines regarding student **health**, **safety**, **and emergency procedures**, including sickness, medication, and allergies.
